Team Managers Reports

Dave Churcher reported on the Senior IC match at Chelmsford. Difficulty with team selection with several athletes pulling out. Despite this there were some good performances from Abigail Jennings (walk), Heather Cubbage (SP & DT), Francesca Sene (TJ) and Amy Bream (S/C). Hampshire finished 65th out of 8 counties.

Re CAU, just 5 ladies entered, Dave will contact re entry procedures. Dave will not be present at these championships.

Richard stated that 7 men had entered the CAU, including 2 defending champions.

There was no senior mens team at the senior Inter counties match as we still have no mens team manager.

Richard reported on the U17 Inter counties match at Le Valley. Very hot conditions. The womens team were third. The mens team had several withdrawals but some good performances and finished 5th.

Hampshire Schools Report

From a good entry at the HSAA Combined Events teams and individuals progressed to the Regional Finals in June at Ashford. Inter Girls, led by Hollie Thurgood in first place won their competition. Junior Girls with Ella Manning 3rd were in 2nd place and Inter Boys were in 3rd place. As the best individuals from the whole country are also invited to the Final in September all of these teams qualified. Elliott Evans won the Junior Boys competition and will progress to the final as an individual along with Emily Cornwall and Hannah Reed (Senior Girls) and Malachi Gair and Charlie Button (Senior boys). Unfortunately we were unable to find a 3rd competitor in the senior age groups to make a team. However, this is the highest representation in the final for a number of years.

As you are probably aware Serena Vincent and Ben Pattison were selected for the European Championships in Hungary last weekend where both finished 4th. Unfortunately Serena suffered an injury which will keep her out of this weekend's English Schools Championships in Birmingham. We have also lost Holly Mills and Mair Edwards who have been selected for the World Youth Championships. Another withdrawal through injury has also weakened the team but we are still hopeful of some good results.

Finally Robert Mays School reached the final of the ESAA Track and Field Cup at Gateshead last Saturday with their Junior Boys. This was the 2nd successive year. They finished a creditable 8th improving their points total in every round.

Technical Officials Report

With just two meetings left for which we have arranged Officials all seems to have gone well. Officials have, by and large, got used to their Appointments being on the website and updates immediately. We have also received some excellent feedback from Officials from outside the County.

One problem we now have is regarding future Officials Courses. The last ones were held at Winchester for over 60 new Officials. We were anticipating using the same venue again but England Athletics are objecting due to the costs. There is a new way of delivering Courses which has come in and it is now necessary to have access to a Track facility. There is no other facility in the County where we could go. Discussions are still ongoing and we are seeking advice/help from others. At present it looks possible that we will be unable to hold Courses in the County unless we can obtain financial help to offset some of these costs. This would mean that prospective new Officials will have to go to a course outside the County and therefore there would not be many, if any, trained.

At present we do not know of a way forward and would welcome any suggestions and help.
