Hampshire Athletics Grand Prix - 20 July 2016, Basingstoke

This was statistically one of the best Grand Prix events we have organised so far, helped by tremendous summer weather, with **395** athletes competing in **536** events. The team of Hampshire Officials & Volunteers worked tirelessly on the night. Leading **Club** participation was:-

The Grand Prix events are building a great reputation for Personal Bests - the 2016 Basingstoke event topped all previous records with **152 athletes** achieving **Personal Bests** as follows:-

## SIAB Schools International – 16 July 2016, Ashford

4 Hampshire Clubs representatives achieved medals in the English Schools winning intermediate age- group at the Schools International:- 3000m Walk – 1<sup>st</sup> Chris Snook, Aldershot Javelin – 2<sup>nd</sup> Tom Hewson, Andover 1500m Steeplechase – 3<sup>rd</sup> Maisie Grice, Aldershot Shot – 3<sup>rd</sup> Gaia Osborne, Portsmouth

European Youth Championships – July 2016, Tbilisi, Georgia
 In the first edition of these Championships, Holly Mills, Andover achieved a gold medal in the Long Jump, and Lucy Pygott, Aldershot achieved a bronze medal in the 3000m. Alastair Chalmers, Guernsey won his heat of the 400m Hurdles.

#### IAAF World U20 Championships July 19-24 2016, Bydgoszcz, Poland

A number of Hampshire Club representatives performed with distinction in these World Junior Championships:-

Oliver Bromby, Southampton ran a  $10.37\ 100m\ PB$  for  $3^{rd}$  in his semi final, and achieved a  $6^{th}$  place as part of the GB 4 x 100m relay team. Cameron Chalmers, Guernsey ran a PB of 46.51 in his 400m semi final

## Hampshire Clubs 2016 Track & Field Season

Most Hampshire Clubs enjoyed successful T&F seasons, with Southampton AC achieving promotion to the Premier Division of the British League in 2017, and promotion to Division 2 of the UK Womens League; also winning the UKYDL National U13/U15 Championships, and Southern Regional Masters Final.

## C.A.U. INTER-COUNTIES / ENGLAND AAA CHAMPIONSHIPS Bedford 30<sup>th</sup> / 31<sup>st</sup> July 2015

For the second time these Championships incorporated the newly resurrected England AAA Championships.

The last minute ambiguity of the timetable, caused confusion for many athletes, so to overcome this, they just turned up at the earliest time quoted.

For the Hampshire Women - Natalie Whitty (Guernsey Is) took 8<sup>th</sup> place in the 1500m Final, whilst Corin Bearpark (Havant) came 7<sup>th</sup> in her 800m Final

Louise Small (AFD) lead all the way in the 3000m Final, but was unfortunately piped at the post for the Gold medal.

The 3000m S/Chase Final saw Amy Bream (Havant) finish 11<sup>th</sup>.

In the Field, Sarah Ellis (Soton) came 10<sup>th</sup> in the Javelin, whilst Phoebe Dawson (B'mouth) took the Bronze medal in the Discus

The Hampshire Ladies finished 9<sup>th</sup> out of 13 in the CAU Division 1 (Aggregate 6<sup>th</sup> overall with the Men's Team)

In the Sprints, Kieran Showler-Davis (BMH) came 5<sup>th</sup> in the semi-final of the 100m, whilst Owen Richardson (BMH) also finished 5<sup>th</sup> in the semi-final of the 200m, with Jamie Robinson (Soton) coming 8<sup>th</sup> in his heat.

Harrison Pocock claimed 5<sup>th</sup> spot in the heats of the 400m.

The Mile final saw Tom Bowerman (AFD) and Thomas MacSwayne (CoP) finish 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> respectively.

Alex Tuetin (CoP) won the Silver medal in the 3000m S/Chase, with Edward Mason (Guernsey I) finishing 14<sup>th</sup>.

Andy Blow (BMH) claimed 4<sup>th</sup> place in the final of the 110m Hurdles, with Sean Adams taking 7<sup>th</sup> spot in the longer 400m Hurdles final.

The Silver medal went to Chris Snook (AFD) in the 3000m Walk.

In the Field, Samuel Bass- Cooper (Soton) and Tom Farres (CoP) finished  $7^{th}$  and  $8^{th}$  respectively in the Pole Vault final.
